Role Description:

Reporting to the Senior Radiographer, assist in the provision of a high quality and effective diagnostic imaging service, whilst assuring the optimum quality of care for patients.

Together we will demonstrate safe clinical decision-making and expert care as well as compassionate communication for patients referred to Fitzpatrick Referrals. You will be care driven, have excellent communication skills, exceptionally organised, thorough and be able to support a 24/7 team environment.

Responsibilities and Tasks:

- Work as part of a multidisciplinary team undertaking diagnostic imaging procedures within the ADI department.
- Be flexible with shift working and participate in the weekend on-call system.
- Rotate through different areas of the imaging department – primarily CT and MRI and occasionally fluoroscopy and X-ray.
- Maintain own professional development and HCPC registration.
- Ensure that radiation protection procedures are adhered to at all times including local rules and IRR17.
- Communicate effectively and appropriately with all colleagues at all times.
- Undertake Quality Assurance procedures on a daily basis and report any equipment errors or failures to the appropriate person.
- Accurately input patient data regarding imaging procedures and contrast injections onto the paper and computer systems.
- Maintain patient and client confidentiality at all times.
- Ensure patient comfort at all times and assist colleagues with patient care when required.
- Assist in the safe administration of CT and MRI contrast agents.
- Maintain a clean and tidy department and ensure stock is checked and filled regularly.
- Ensure all imaging is backed up and transfer appropriate imaging to external practices when required.
- Comply with all practice policies, procedures and rules.
- In addition to your main duties you will be required to carry out such other duties consistent with your position to meet the needs of the practice. The practice may from time to time require you to conduct your duties outside of your normal working hours (including additional hours during the week and weekends).
